**Xiuli Wang** is an Associate Professor of School of History and Culture, South China Normal University, Guangzhou, China. She got her B.A. and M.A. from Hebei Teacher's University (Shijiazhang, China) and Ph. D. from Ji'nan University (Guangzhou, China). Her academic field is the economic and social history of middle and late imperial China. Her major academic publication is *Acculturation and Historical Evolution: Study on Commerce in Southeast China during Yuan, Macao, 2005*. She is the director of an academic project on " *Study on the Merchant-scholar Cultural Circle in South China during Late Yuan and Early Ming Period*" (The National Social Science Fund of China, 2011- 2016).

From 2006 to 2007, Prof. Xiuli Wang was an visiting scholar of Harvard-Yenching Institute, and her research program is "Vicissitudes of the Merchant-scholar Cultural Circle in *Taicang* around the Turning Point of Yuan and Ming".

Prof. Wang's academic interests in the recent years include Maritime Merchants and Sea Transportation in Yuan-Ming China, the Cooperation between Merchants and Scholars and the Merchant-scholar Cultural Circle in South-China during Late Yuan and Early Ming dynasties, the Role of Economic and Cultural Elite in the developing of Agriculture-Commerce Society in Song-Yuan-Ming China, the Position and Cultural Mission of the Traditional *Shi* (literati) under the Mongol Rule, the role of China and Chinese People in the making of the world, attempting to pursue a deep understanding of the Song-Yuan-Ming society and its effects on late imperial and modern Chinese history through a careful tracing of the historical records of various types .

## COURSES TAUGHT

FOR POSTGRADUATES:

***Historical Theories and Methodology*** gives brief introduction of the main historical theories and teach the students how to pursue historical research

***Introduction of Historical Sources: Yuan Period*** gives brief introduction of the historical sources studying Yuan China and teach the students how to use them

***Specialized Studies on Yuan Period China***, workshop on a series of focus study on Yuan Society

FOR UNDERGRADUATES:

***History of Middle and Late Imperial China*** gives speeches on Chinese History from 581 to 1840.

***Social History of Yuan Dynasty*** gives speeches on Chinese Society from 1260 to 1368.

***Sinology*** gives brief introduction of the developing of Sinology in foreign countries, including France, Japan, America, etc. and interpretation for masterpieces in English.

***Specific English in the Field of History*** gives the students a rudimental training in the ability of English sources reading in the field of history.
